"Important Tax Notice: Annual dues are \$445.00. (\$198 to National {NAHB}}/\$70 to State {NCHBA} The dues portion paid to the North Carolina Home Builders Association are not tax deductible as charitable contributions for income tax purposes. However, they may be tax deductible as ordinary and necessary business expenses subject to restrictions imposed as a result of association lobbying activities. The NCHBA estimates that the non-deductible portion of your 2025 dues – the portion which is allocable to lobbying – is 51%." For a member who pays their regular NCHBA dues of \$70.00 in 2025, 51% or \$35.70 will not be eligible for deduction as a business expense, and \$34.30 of the NCHBA dues may be tax deductible as an ordinary and necessary business expense. The National Association of Home Builders has made a similar calculation with respect to their portion of builder and associate 2025 dues. For 2025, NAHB has determined that 16% of their regular annual dues of \$198.00 is non-deductible. Thus, for the NAHB portion of dues \$31.68 is not deductible and \$166.32 may be deductible.
